Mr. Schott provided the Committee with a brief update to the meeting he attended on January 13th. He stated the next meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 27th at 2:00 p.m. He also stated February 3rd at 2:00 is scheduled to be the Committee's last meeting.

KGB TEXAS CONTRACT

Mr. Schott reported he had been directed by the Board at its last meeting to consider re-engaging KGB for its services, as well as looking at other firms. At this time, Mr. Schott presented the Committee a contract submitted by KGB for its review. Mr. Smith made a motion to accept the contract as presented and take it to the full Board for approval. After some discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

GUARDIANSHIP REQUIREMENTS (SECTION 6.13 PENSION LAW)

Mr. Schott informed the Committee that Letters of Guardianship are only issued to be effective for a specific period of time usually one year. It is possible for a guardianship to be granted but then to lapse later, because annual accountings have not been filed or other legal requirements have not been met. To make sure guardianships are current and meet legal requirements, the Fund should request current Letters of Guardianship each year.

After much discussion, the Committee directed Mr. Schott to notify members affected by this requirement through certified mail.
