REVIEW & DISCUSSION

BILLS FILED IN THE 87TH (2021) LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Mr. Reed turned the meeting over to Gail Jensen, General Counsel, to provide a brief summary of bills filed in the 87th Legislative Session that may have an impact on or otherwise be of interest to the Pension Fund. Ms. Jensen discussed several bills in the areas of pension funds, law enforcement, and open government. She noted that none of the bills filed would have a critical impact on the Pension Fund, although several require monitoring, including bills proposing to convert defined benefit plans to defined contribution plans, a bill relating to QDROs, a bill related to the provision of a 1-year paid leave of absence to firefighters and police officers and several Open Meetings Act bills. Ms. Jensen advised that she would continue to monitor the progress of the bills and keep the Committee apprised.
