	Mr. Smith moved to approve the Minutes from the November 20, 2023, meeting of the Personnel/Audit Committee. The motion carried unanimously.
	2024 Annual Budget
	Mark Gremmer, Deputy Director, provided the Committee the updated 2024 Annual Budget. Mr. Schott informed the Committee that the updated version incorporated changes requested by the Committee at the November meeting, including changes to staff compensation and a modest increase in

meeting, including changes to staff compensation and a modest increase in the staff travel budget (to allow Investment staff to resume due diligence visits to managers which had been postponed due to COVID-19). Mr. Schott noted that in addition, the Pension Fund's Actuarial Experience Study (which must be done every five years) is scheduled for 2024, and so the projected cost of \$48,000 also was added into the Budget.

Upon reconvening, Mr. Smith made a motion to recommend the Board approve the 2024 Budget as presented, with the additional changes discussed in Executive Session. The motion carried unanimously.
